- AD150 Lucian of Samosata wrote "true story", a tale of travelers to the moon
- 11th Century Song Dynasty used for the first time some exploding powder as a propellant
- 1232 First flying bombs to defend Chinese city
- 1288 Arab Forces used rockets in an attack of Valencia, Spain
- 1609 Johannes Kepler described his laws of planetary motions
- 1634 Johannes Kepler wrote a tale of an expedition to the moon
- 1650 Cyrano de Bergerac suggested to use a rocket to travel into space
- 1687 Isaac Newton discovered his three laws of motions, and a force called gravity.
- 1865 Jules Verne "from the Earth to the moon"

ROCKET PIONNEERS

- 1903 Konstantin Tsiolkovski wrote a technical book about technic to fly with a rocket. CCCP
- 1923 Hermann Oberth published his book "The Rocket into Interplanetary Space", as not accepted as a doctor work. Germany
- 1926 Robert Goddard launch first a rocket with liquid fuel. USA
- 1929 Fritz Lang "Frau im Mond" with a real rocket of Hermann Oberth. Germany
- 1942, OCT 3 Agregat 4, first flight into space by a rocket, Penemünde. Germany

1959, OCT 7 – Luna 3 toke first pictures from the backside of the moon. CCCP

1959, APR 9 – Selection of the seven Mercury Astronauts. USA

1960, MAY 30 – Selection of the first group of six cosmonauts. CCCP

1961, JAN 31 – Mercury MR-2, Chimp Ham flew into space. USA

1965, DEC15 – Gemini 8, First docking in space. USA

1966, JAN14 – Death of Chief constructor Sergey Korolev. CCCP

1966, JUN02 – Surveyor 1, first soft landing on the moon. USA

1967, JAN 27 – Fire onboard Apollo 1, killing astronauts Gus Grissom, Ed White and Roger Chaffee. USA

1967, APR 23 – Crash of Soyuz 1, killing cosmonaut Vladimir Komarov. CCCP

1967, NOV 09 – Apollo 4, first automatic flight of the moon rocket Saturn V. USA

1968, JAN 22 – Apollo 6, first automatic flight of the Lunar Module (LM) in Earth orbit. USA

1968, SEP 18- Zond 5, unmanned spacecraft around the moon. CCCP

1968, OCT 11-22 – Apollo 7, first manned flight of the program Apollo. Crew: Wally Schirra, Don Eisele and Walt Cunnigham. USA

1968, DEC 21-27 – Apollo 8, the first human flight around the moon. Crew: Frank Borman, Jim Lovell and Bill Anders. USA

1969, FEB 21 – Explosion during launch of the first moon rocket N1. CCCP

1969, MAR 03-13 – Apollo 9, first manned flight of the Lunar Module (LM) in Earth orbit. Crew: Jim McDivitt, Dave Scott, Russel Schweickart. USA

1969, MAY 18-26 - Apollo 10, first manned flight of the Lunar Module (LM) in moon orbit. Crew: Tom Stafford, John Young, Gene Cernan. USA

1969, JUL 21 – Luna 15 crashed on the moon, while trying to sample rock before USA. CCCP

1969, JUL 16-24 – Apollo 11, first men on the lunar surface. Short stay on the lunar surface. Crew: Neil Armstrong, Buzz Aldrin, Michael Collins. USA

1969, NOV 14-24 – Apollo 12, pinpoint landing. Two days stay on the lunar surface. Crew: Pete Conrad, Alan Bean, Dick Gordon.

1970, APR 11-17 - Apollo 13, mission cancelled after an explosion on board. Crew: Jim Lovell, Fred Haise, Jack Swigert. USA

1970, NOV 17- Luna 17, first automatic rover named Lunokhod on the lunar surface. CCCP

1970, DEC 15 – Venera 7, first soft landing on Venus. CCCP

1971, JAN 31-FEB 9 – Apollo 14, first landing in a mountainous terrain. Two days stay on the lunar surface. Crew: Al Shepard, Edgar Mitchell, Stu Roosa. USA

1971, APR 19- Sayut 1, first Space Station in Earth orbit. CCCP

1971, JUL 26-AUG7 – Apollo 15, first extended scientific mission on the moon. First time with a moon rover. Three days stay on the lunar surface. Crew: Dave Scott, Jim Irwin, Al Worden. USA

1971, DEC 2 – Mars 3, first soft landing on Mars. CCCP

1972, APR 16-27 - Apollo 16, first landing on a highland of the moon. Three days stay on the lunar surface. Crew: John Young, Charlie Duke, Ken Mattingly. USA

1972, DEC 7-19 - Apollo 17, last mission on the moon. Three days stay on the lunar surface. Crew: Gene Cernan, Jack Schmitt, Ron Evans. USA

1973, MAR 25-JUN 22 – Skylab 2, first manned mission in the first US space station. Crew: Pete Conrad, Joseph Kerwin, Paul Weitz. USA

1975, JUL 15-24 – Apollo-Soyuz, first joint space flight between Soviets and Americans, marking the official end of the space race. USA-CCCP

1976, FEB 17- Soviet manned lunar program officially abandoned. CCCP
